Purpose

This policy ensures wireless devices meet minimum security requirements. Only wireless systems that meet the requirements of this policy or have been granted an exclusive waiver by the Information Technology Services Division are approved for connectivity to Georgia Highlands College's networks.

Scope

This policy covers all wireless data communication devices (e.g., computers, mobile devices, etc.) connected to any of Georgia Highlands College's internal networks. Wireless devices and/or networks without any connectivity to Georgia Highlands College's networks do not fall under the purview of this policy.

Policy

All wireless access points connected to the Georgia Highlands College network must be registered and approved by the Information Technology Services Division. All wireless LAN controllers and access points must be monitored and managed by a central software system. Production wireless network access requires a valid account on the faculty/staff or student domain. Guest wireless access is only granted via a guest wireless account and is on an independent, restricted network. Please refer to the ITS Network Security Standard for additional requirements.

Enforcement

Any employee found to have violated this policy may be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including termination of employment.
